In this way, it is hoped that every athlete may achieve his personal educational goals. To

League Expectation

- that each team will have an Academic Advisor(s) to support the academic expectations outlined in its Education Policy
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- that the Ontario Hockey League will convene meetings of the Academic Advisors to plan and implement the education initiatives of the League and each team
- that the Ontario Hockey League will provide educational support material for all teams, players and families, e.g., Marking Your Mark in the OHL, Best of Both Worlds, OHL Education Manual

Player Expectations

- that all players adhere to their respective teams' Education Policy
- that all players be expected to attend high school until graduation
- that all players enrolled in educational programs are expected to participate fully in all classes and strive to maintain a passing grade
- that all players be encouraged to pursue post-secondary pathways

Academic Advisor Expectation

- to liaise with players/schools/team and parents
- to communicate with Team Management to support the team's Education Policy
- to facilitate the registration process with players at high school and post-secondary pathways
- to provide academic counseling and support including facilitating tutor assistance when necessary
- to support league educational initiatives
