- 3.3 The Player undertakes to respect all the rules which the Club enacts at any time pursuant to Section 7 of the present contract and, among others, the Player undertakes to respect the
  - 3.3.1 Gambling on any amaleur hockey game whatsoever is prohibited.
  - 2.3.2 The Player must be on time for all Club practices, games, meetings or other events related to the Club. The Club shall provide the Player with notice of each scheduled event specifying the time and place at which the Player is required to report.
    - (i) If the Player misses a scheduled team transportation, he shall be solely responsible for paying for his own bravel arrangements to the city in which he is required to meet the Club. He shall also be subject to a fine, at the discretion of the Club.
    - (4) If the Player misses a scheduled practice without valid pre-approved permission from the Club's physician, head-coach or general manager, he shall be fined at the discretion of the Club.
