

Condo owners launch class-action lawsuits following falling glass incidents

The owners and renters of two condo buildings which had panes of glass fall from their balconies are suing the developers and contractors.

Law firms Falconer Charney and Sutt Strosberg have filed a class-action lawsuit on their behalf, which names the developers, contractors, manufacturers and architects as the defendants.

The suit involves residents from the Murano Towers (Bay and College Streets) and Festival Tower (John and King Streets), which are linked to Lanterra Developments, Bay Grenville Properties and King and John Festival Corporation.

The plaintiffs allege they have been unable to use their balconies and outdoor spaces for several months, since the accidents occurred.
