

## Two Downtown Condos Face Class-Action Law Suits Over Falling Balcony Glass

Residents of two downtown condos have filed a \$30-million (\$15 million each) class action lawsuit after planes of glass fell from their blaconies last summer.

The two seperate suits against Murano Towers (Bay and College) and Festival Tower (King and John), allege that the developers are responsible for the falling glass. As a result, residents were not able to use their balconies "for months"
